He did his primary school at Mayanga Primary School and went to complete his secondary school education at Mungwi Secondary School in Kasama in December 1976. Thereafter, he was recruited to go and participate in national duties at Ndola National Service Camp before he joined Nkrumah Teachers' College in Kabwe in 1977. Between 1979 and 1988, Mr Kaule worked as a secondary school teacher at Luanshya Girls Secondary School. From 1988 to 1993 he worked for the Zambia Educational Publishing House as a book editor. From 1993 to 1995 he worked as an editor for general titles at Timesprintpak, Ndola. From 1995 to July 2009 he worked as Assistant Registrar at the University of Zambia, Lusaka. From 1995 to 2009 he worked as a Consultant Editor; working on Cibemba Readers and short story books for Macmillan Zambia, Zambia Educational Publishing House and processing Icibemba-English or English-Icibemba translations for numerous organisations.

Starting from end of July 2009 to date Mr Kaule has worked as Acting Publisher of the

University of Zambia Press (UNZA Press) in Lusaka. Mr Kaule has worked as a teacher, publisher and an expert in communication for development with keen interest in developing teen story books and poetry.
